Notes from Pastor Jeff

Where in the COVID-19 world are we?

When it comes to doing typical church ministry during this COVID-19 time, even the simplest plans are anything but simple. We've just now gotten to the point where we can offer a fairly simple in-person worship service on Sunday mornings. But according to the current "Healthy at Work" plan outlined by our governor, we will reach a significant milestone on June 29. On that day, groups of 50 or more will be permitted to meet, with restrictions. At that point, assuming that the plan does not change, we will be able to take a step forward with our Sunday School and our Student Ministry.

For our Student Ministry, starting June 29 we will begin offering summer "park nights," which will involve the group getting together in-person at local parks. This would be a small but important step forward for our Student Ministry, which so far has only been able to meet online during COVID-19.

For our Sunday School, we are encouraging all kids' classes, all student classes, and most of our adult classes to meet online for the foreseeable future. Social distancing requirements prevent us from offering a full-scale in-person Sunday School experience right now. Staying online also allows Sunday School classes the greatest flexibility and participation during a time when many people can't (or won't) come to an in-person meeting.

However, for our adult Sunday School classes that have been unable to meet online, starting June 29 we will begin offering large rooms in the church building for them to use once a week (on a non-Sunday). This will allow those classes to start meeting again in a socially-distant manner. In this way, we hope to have as many people as possible engaging in fellowship and Bible learning with their Sunday School classes.

There is still so much we don't know about how we'll be able to do ministry this year during COVID-19. But this is what we think we know right now, and we'll have to leave the rest to the Lord. Thank you for all your understanding, support, and especially your prayers!

Minister of Worship Update

We began searching for our next Minister of Worship about a year ago. So we are very excited to announce that we are bringing a candidate to HBC in view of a call to become our next Minister of Worship! Here is the plan to present him to our church:

Tuesday, June 23

A letter with the candidate's name and information will be mailed out to active resident members. We will also have this information available to those who attend our worship services on June 27-28.

Saturday, June 27

The candidate will lead Worship during an in-person service from 5:00pm–6:00pm. Doors will open at 4:45.

After worship, we will start our Quarterly Members' Meeting and collect a ballot vote on calling the candidate.

Sunday, June 28

The candidate will lead Worship during an in-person service from 11:00am-12:00pm. Doors will open at 10:45.

Worship will be available streaming online, either with a live stream of Sunday's service or a recorded stream of Saturday's service.

After worship, we will resume our Members' Meeting and collect a ballot vote on calling the candidate.

From 12:30pm–2:30pm, we will allow members who were not present in the worship services to drive-by and vote under the covered drive near Room 101.

At 3:00pm in the Worship Center, we will resume the Members' Meeting for all members who wish to attend. We will report the vote and conduct the rest of the quarterly meeting.

So use that weekend to learn about the candidate and watch him lead worship either in-person or online! If you plan to attend in-person worship that weekend, then please watch your email for how to RSVP for one of the services. If you do not use email, then please call the church office and tell Hannah which service you plan to attend.
