exhausting, but after each VBS, I always feel a sadness that it is already over.

This year, VBS was called *Keepers of the Kingdom*, a theme centered around the battle between God's Kingdom (the good kingdom) and the enemy's kingdom (the bad kingdom). The kids also learned about different pieces of the Armor of God each day from Ephesians 6. We spent our days focusing on the purposes and importance of each piece, and how necessary this armor is in the battle.

Through Bible lessons, singing songs, creating crafts, eating delicious snacks, running around outdoors, missions time, and the daily skit, the truths of Ephesians 6 were being drilled into the kids over and over. Each specific activity they did had a purpose: to teach them the Word of God.

Children can grasp more than we give them credit for, and VBS is a specific opportunity to watch them comprehend deep Biblical truths at an age-appropriate level. When they are dancing or reading or learning or eating, it is with purpose. The work is worth the potential reward—children coming to know the One who has always known them.

VBS is such a special week in the life of a church for numerous reasons. It is an opportunity for so many giftings and talents to be used—cooking or baking, teaching, singing, administration, decorating so many diverse skillsets are needed to pull it off.

We also get the chance to welcome many people into our building that either do not go to church, or attend somewhere else. This year, we had multiple children come to us from other religious groups. What an opportunity to teach God's truth to those who may not be hearing it regularly, or at all!

VBS brings us together and also stretches us out in the most unique way. It is a week of serving, giving, loving, teaching. We raised almost \$2,000 this year for Re:Center ministries! The reach of this one week goes so beyond a single group of kids.

So, what's next? We pray. We pray that our efforts have and will bring more people into the Good Kingdom. We pray that those who heard the good news of the gospel would be drawn in. We pray that we would love and care well for those who are new to this special family of God and for those who begin coming to church.
